

Symmetry is a starting point. Respecting the semiotic of elements (death, genetic history, age, humanity itself as a sign, expiration), and trying just to confront them themselves with a sculptural image, geometric and being at the same time an airtight container completely sealed, on a basic form (globe, ball, moon).

La simetría es un punto de partida.
